Plain Language Summary – Financial Assistance Policy

The Financial Assistance Policy at Prairie View exists to provide eligible patients discounted emergent or medically necessary services. This summary provides a brief overview of Prairie View's Financial Assistance Policy. Patients seeking Financial Assistance must apply for the program.

Eligible Services

Emergency Services and medically necessary services provided by Prairie View practitioners and locations within Harvey, Marion, and McPherson counties.

Eligible Patients

Patients receiving eligible services who complete a Financial Evaluation form may be eligible for Financial Assistance. Patients with income that is less than 200% of the poverty level may be eligible for discounted rates on a sliding scale as detailed in the "Financial Assistance Rate Schedule" of the Financial Assistance Policy.

How to Apply

Patients may apply for Financial Assistance in person at Admissions or by meeting with a Prairie View Financial Counselor. Applications for Financial Assistance may also be obtained online at Prairie View's website. A Financial Assistance Packet can also be requested via phone by calling Prairie View at (316) 284-6400.
